

# Crisp Road Vehicle Bay – Marshall Briefing

## Marshal 1

- Establish signage on Queens Caroline Street.
- Operate stop go board.
- Maintain radio communication with other traffic marshalls at all times. Particularly marshal 4.
- Maintain a line of site with other marshalls wherever possible. Particularly marshal 4.

## Marshal 2

- Open and close Queen Caroline Street vehicle gate.
- Pay particular attention of vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists coming up Queen Caroline Street from the Thames Footpath.
- Maintain radio communication with other traffic marshalls at all times.
- Maintain a line of site with other marshalls wherever possible.

## Marshal 3

- Establish signage and barriers associated with the Crisp Road controlled vehicle bay.
- Open and close barriers to form controlled and fully enclosed vehicle loading bay.
- Do not establish barriered area until all other marshals have confirmed they are in position and all signage positioned and displayed as per the traffic management plan attached to this briefing.
- During lifting operations, where there is a risk of the load passing outside the controlled vehicle loading bay, instruct all other marshals to stop traffic until the lift is clear of the road, at which time traffic can be allowed to flow.
- Maintain radio communication with other traffic marshalls at all times.
- Maintain a line of site with other marshalls wherever possible.
- Keep all unauthorised personnel out of controlled vehicle loading bay.

## Marshal 4

- Establish signage on Crisp Road.
- Operate stop go board.
- Maintain radio communication with other traffic marshalls at all times. Particularly marshal 1.
- Maintain a line of site with other marshalls wherever possible. Particularly marshal 1.
